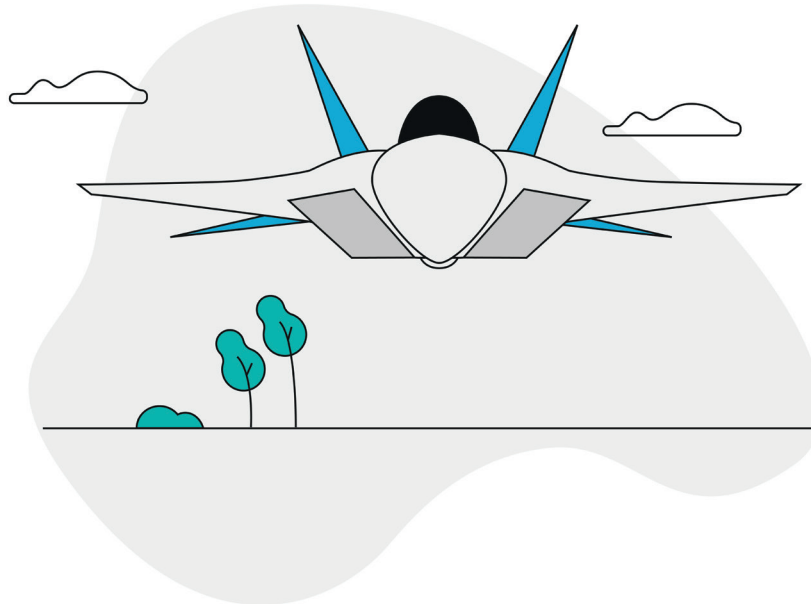


Make It Fly
